







In 1833, Abbot Urbain Loir Mongazon opened a small seminary of 40 students and 6 teachers. In 1835, the chapel and buildings that remain to this day were built. The chapel is now registered as a French historical monument.

The school grew over the years to accommodate an increasing number of students. Today, it offers over 23,000m2 of living space and can welcome 2,250 students.

In addition to the traditional school infrastructure, students will find sports grounds, two gymnasiums with climbing walls and a variety of spaces with specialized equipment (library, amphitheater, media center, recreational rooms, etc.).

With a strong mission and a core set of values, the school supports students on their journey towards success and out into the world.

Mongazon bears the label "lycée des métiers" (vocational high school), and is one of the schools associated with UNESCO.



Getting to know Angers

Angers is a city of 154,508 inhabitants in the northwest of France. Located in the Pays de la Loire region and an hour east of Nantes, Angers stands out today for its proficiency in the botany field: Végépolys is the leading European cluster of businesses and research facilities in plant biology. Angers' museums and universities, entertainment offering make it an important cultural hub. Its rich heritage has granted Angers the "Ville d'art d'histoire" designation (city of Arts and heritage).

MONGAZON BOARDING SCHOOL

The boarding school's mission is to tailor the care and attention put into each student in order for them to suceed in all aspects of their adult life. The educational team works in partnership with the families and teaching staff. They help their students live in community and respect of one another. Communication and compliance are fostered as values and life skills.

Seconde and Première students are hosted on school grounds in a dedicated building (125 bed capacity). Lodging is set at 4 students per room in Seconde, and 3 students per room in Première. A separate building located in the back of the campus accommodates up to 70 Terminale students in single rooms.





The boarding school team also encourages open-mindedness and team bonding through various activities and sports. Each evening, students can relax and enjoy some down time. The amphitheater is home to a movie night every Thursday and students debate one of the films shown once a month. Once a week, students can take part in strength training, futsal, dance, rock climbing, etc. All under the supervision of a coach. Boarding students also have the opportunity to exercise outdoors or take part in enrichment activities in agreement with school authorities and families.
