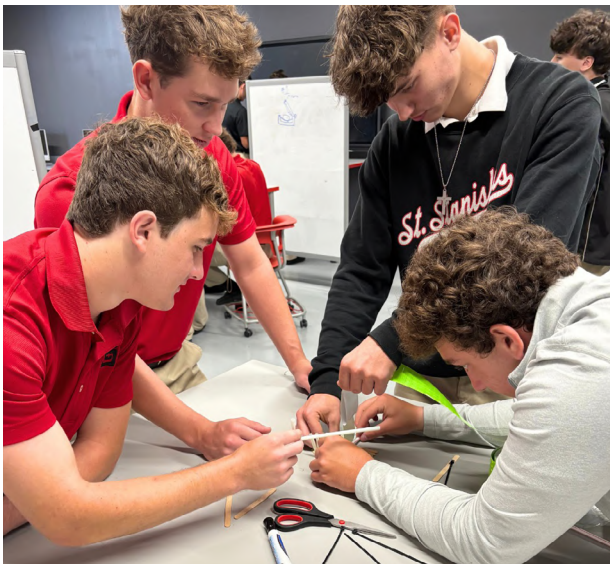
Residential Life

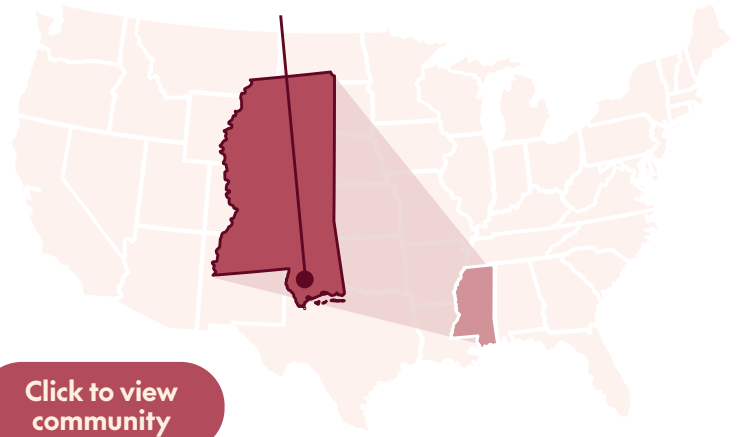
