## Student Accomplishments

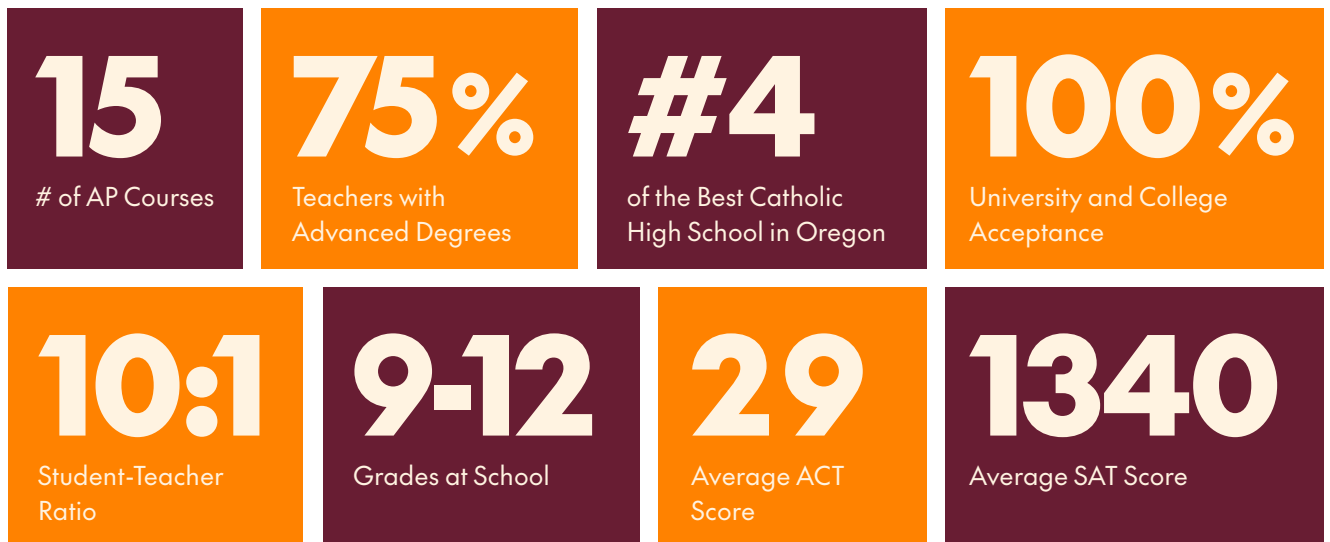

## Campus Facilities

The 43-acre campus includes a science building, athletic center, turf field, auditorium, library, greenhouse, and weight room. Every student is provided a MacBook Air to support equitable access to technology. Facilities promote both academic and co-curricular engagement, including performance spaces, laboratories, and areas for athletics and outdoor recreation.

## Athletics and Arts

Athletics are central to student life, with 79% of students participating in one or more teams. The school has earned 28 state championships, emphasizing teamwork, sportsmanship, and competition.

Valley Catholic provides a strong fine and performing arts program with dedicated class periods for music. Students can pursue band, orchestra, and choir as core subjects, while the drama department stages two annual productions. Nearly half of students engage in fine arts courses.

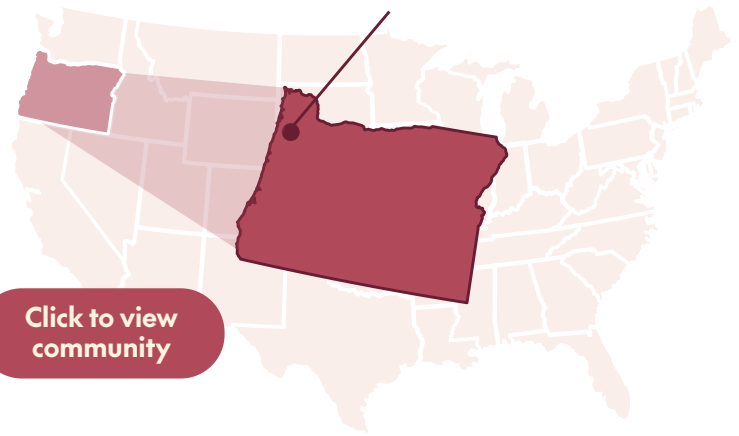

## Community

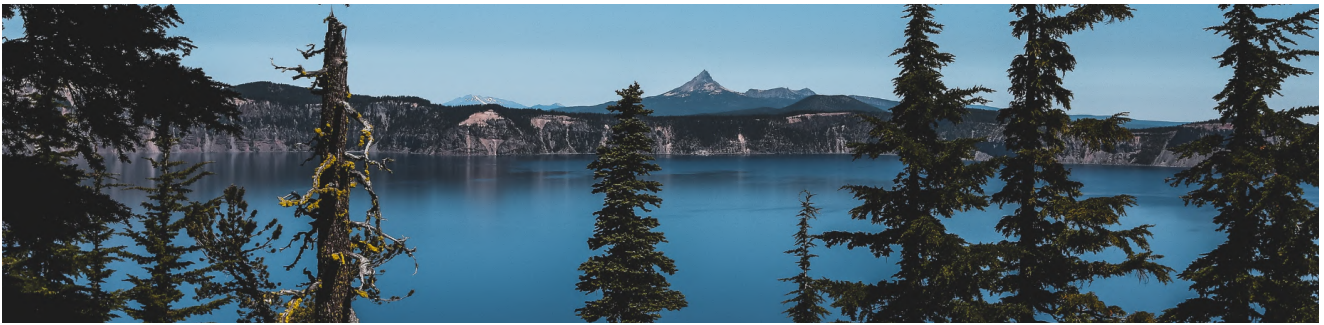
