Springdale Prep offers a broad curriculum including Advanced Placement (AP), Honors, dual-enrollment, and International Baccalaureate (IB) options. Upper School requirements include community service and a Senior Research Capstone or IB Diploma track. Small class sizes and low student-teacher ratios support individualized instruction. Dual enrollment options allow qualified seniors to earn college credit, and Honors and AP courses prepare students for post-secondary expectations. The school is fully accredited and emphasizes global citizenship alongside academic rigor.

The campus spans over 50 acres of rolling countryside in Northern Maryland. Academic facilities support a wide curriculum including STEM, arts, and humanities; classrooms are complemented by spaces for library/media research and senior seminar work. Outdoor areas provide space for sports and recreation. Boarding residences and shared dining and common areas integrate day and boarding students.

Residential Life

Boarding is integrated with the academic program and open to international and domestic students. Dormitories include shared rooms with access to residential support staff. Communal dining and lounges facilitate social interaction. Students from Asia, Europe, and across the United States live on campus year-round, participating in school activities and weekend programming alongside day students.

Athletics and Arts

Springdale Prep offers a range of athletic opportunities at competitive levels. Students participate in NCAA-certified sports and non-traditional offerings emphasizing fitness and teamwork within a diverse student body.

Arts programs are woven into the curriculum with studio and performing options supported by dedicated instructors.

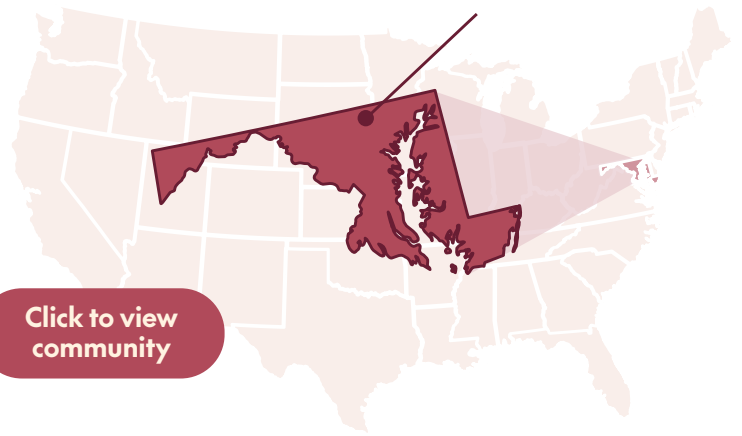
