SCHOOL PROFILE

St. Mary's School in Oregon boasts impressive rankings of #1 Best Catholic High School in Oregon, #2 Best Boarding High School in Oregon, and #3 Best High School for STEM in Oregon on Niche.com in addition to their A+ rating. St. Mary's sits on 24 acres with an 8-lane all-weather track, five acres of athletics fields, gymnasiums and multiple buildings. In addition, their Fine Arts and Athletic Center features a full gymnasium, fitness center, two art classrooms and two music classrooms. They continue to grow and build more of these state-of-the-art facilities, recently adding a Student Commons Area and STEM Center which is complete with nine science classrooms (including two robotic labs).

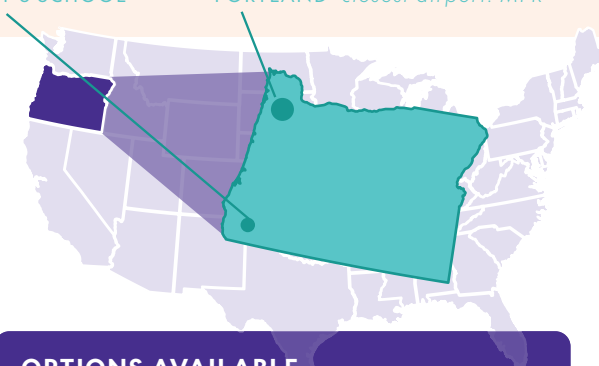
DORMITORIES AND STUDENT LIFE
