## Campus Facilities

The campus spans 24 acres in Medford, Oregon, with academic spaces for science, mathematics, languages, and arts. Athletic facilities support competitive participation in Oregon School Activities Association leagues, including fields and courts for seasonal sports. Modular classrooms and collaborative labs accommodate flexible scheduling and project-based learning. The dormitory is situated near classrooms, the library, and cafeteria, integrating residential life with the academic day. Outdoor spaces support nature-based activities and community events.

## Residential Life

Boarding is available for upper grades, with student residences located on campus. Boarding students live in supervised housing steps from academic buildings, dining areas, and the library. The integrated residential program facilitates full participation in academic and extracurricular life throughout the week and weekend. International and domestic students share residential spaces, engaging in study, community programs, and campus events together.

## Athletics and Arts

St. Mary's is a member of the Oregon School Activities Association and competes in the Far West League. Student athletes participate in multiple sports across fall, winter, and spring seasons, and the school has a history of state championships in various classifications.

Arts programming includes visual and performing arts integrated into the curriculum with opportunities for exhibitions and performances.

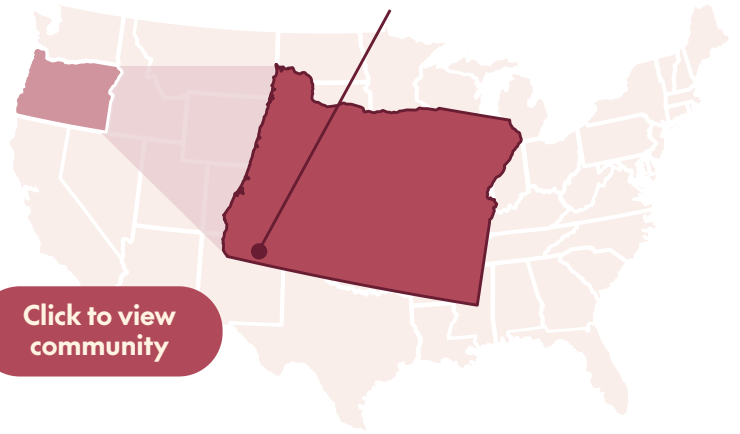
