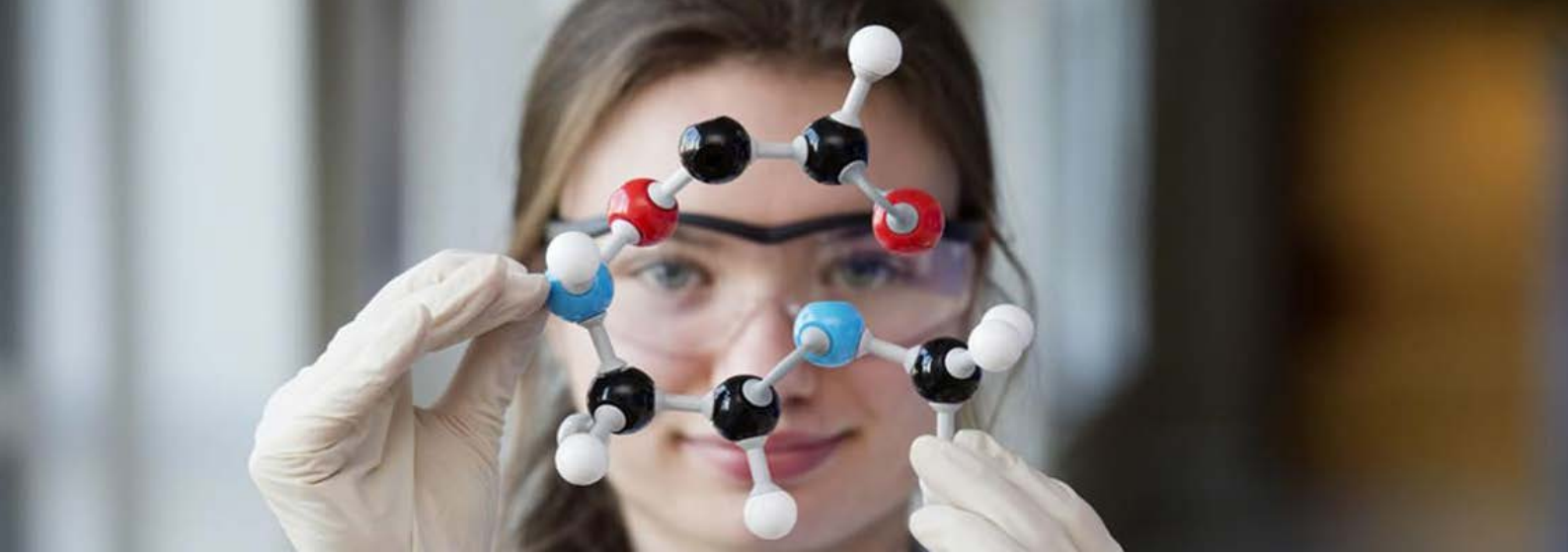

## KILLINEY

Killiney is a seaside resort and suburb in Dún Laoghaire–Rathdown, Ireland. It lies south of neighbouring Dalkey, and approximately 45 minutes from Dublin city centre. The place grew around the 11th century Killiney Church, and became a popular seaside resort in the 19th century. Today it is one of south Dublin's most affluent areas. The coastal areas of Killiney are often compared to the Bay of Naples in Italy. The area is perfect if you love to be beside the seaside – Killiney Strand is a pebble

beach around 2km long, while Whiterock Beach is smaller and sandy. Killiney Hill Park, the area's biggest attraction, is a popular destination for walkers and hikers and boasts magnificent views over Killiney, Dalkey and beyond. From the top of the hill, you can see Dublin city and on a clear day, the view over the Irish Sea extends as far as the Welsh mountains. Choosing to live in Killiney, you can explore both the Irish coast and Dublin.
