The « Collège Episcopal Saint Étienne (CSE) » is a Catholic private secondary school situated in Strasbourg.

Première & Terminale (Year 11 & 12)



The "classe de Première" introduces specialty teachings while keeping a significant amount of compulsory core subjects. Students must choose 3 additional subject (4 hours per week per subject).

The "classe de Terminale" reinforces specialization from a higher education perspective. Students must choose 2 additional subject (6 hours per week per subject).

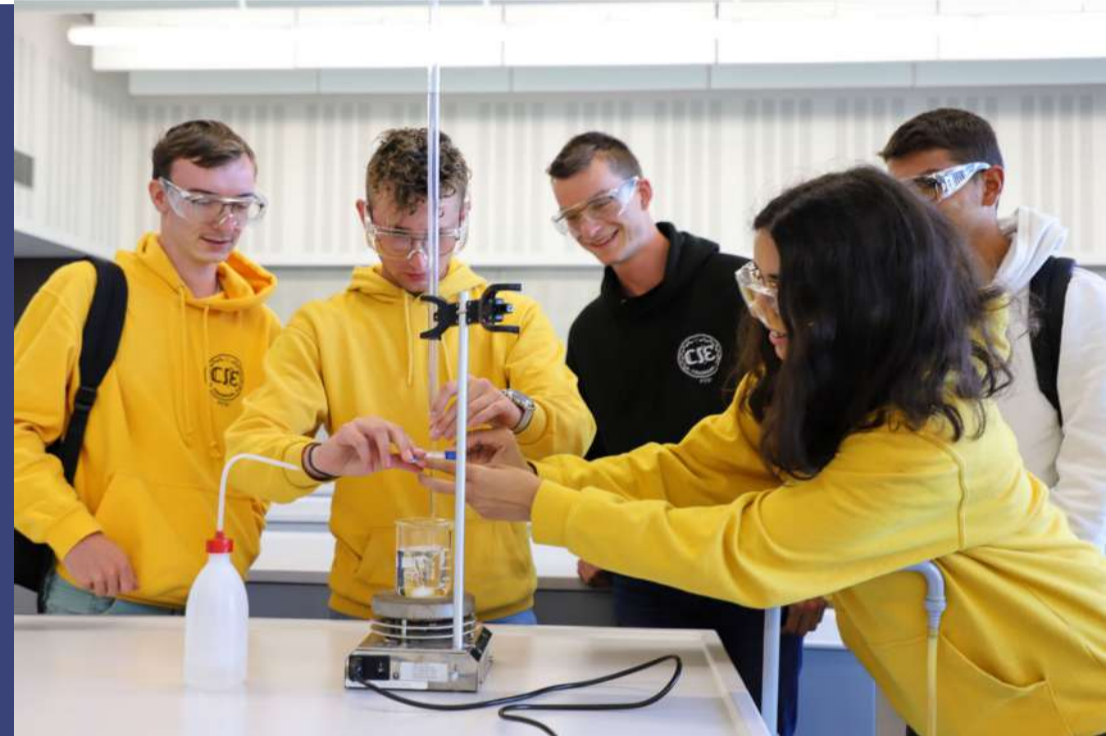
