The "classe de Première" introduces specialty teachings while keeping a significant amount of compulsory core subjects. Students must choose 3 additional subjects (4 hours per week per subject). Students can choose one option.

The "classe the Terminale" reinforces specialization from a higher education perspective. Students must choose 2 additional subjects (6 hours per week per subject). Students can choose one option.
