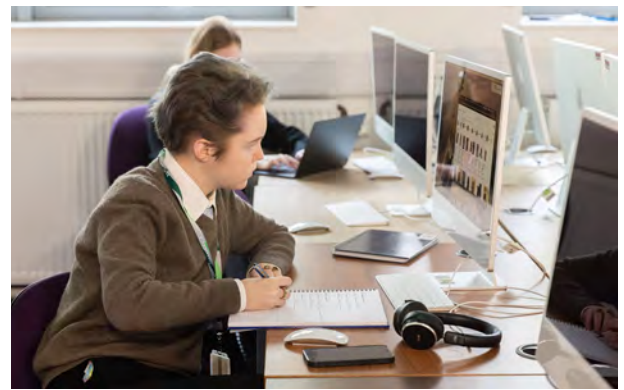

Academic Excellence

Sheffield College Sixth Form offers a broad academic and vocational curriculum designed to support progression to university and employment. Students can choose from 19 A-Level subjects, alongside GCSEs, BTEC qualifications, T-Levels, Extended Project Qualification and University Foundation programmes. The college reports a 98% A-Level pass rate, with teaching delivered by subject specialists, many with industry experience. Strong employer and university links provide access to work experience and progression opportunities. Students benefit from flexibility in subject choice, including the opportunity to change courses early in the programme, supporting informed academic decision-making and strong preparation for higher education, including Russell Group universities.

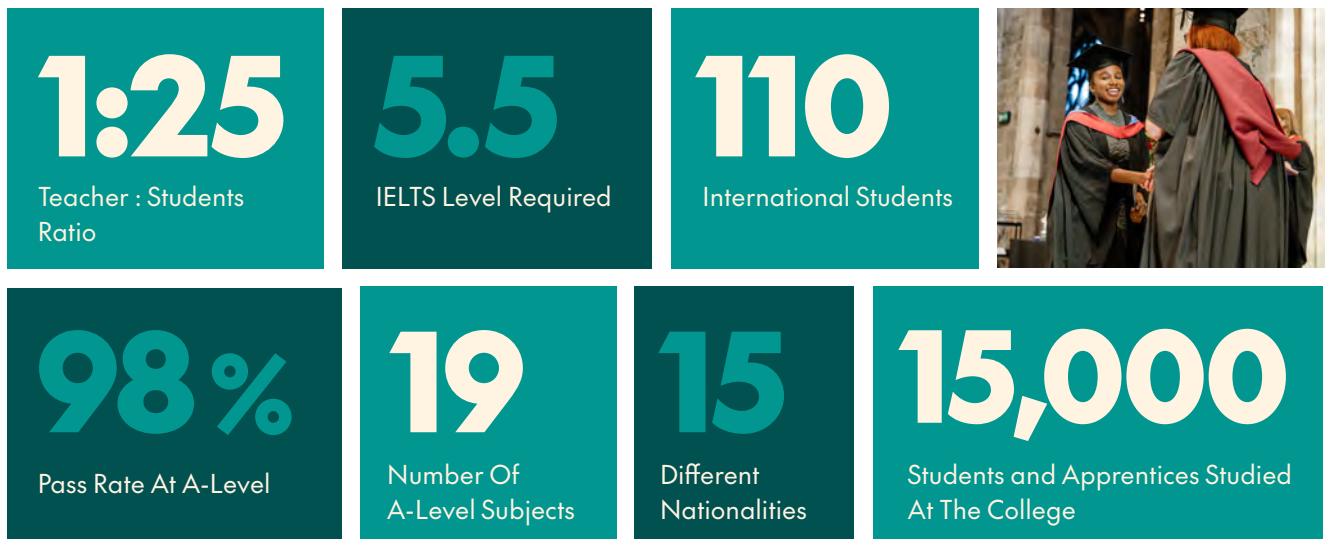

Campus Facilities

Sheffield College Sixth Form is based on a large, centrally located city campus with direct tram access. Facilities include science laboratories, IT suites, media and graphic design studios, photography studios, rehearsal and performance spaces, and specialist vocational workshops. Students also have access to a sports hall, fitness suite and outdoor sports areas. All facilities are integrated within the campus, supporting easy movement between academic, creative and sports spaces throughout the school day.

Life with local host families

International students live with approved local host families in Sheffield. Accommodation typically includes single or shared rooms, daily meals, supervision and pastoral support. Host families help students integrate into local life, while the college provides welfare support and regular check-ins. Travel to campus is usually by public transport, with tram and bus routes offering convenient access from host family homes.

Athletics and Arts

Sheffield College offers structured sports provision through both academic study pathways and extracurricular programmes. The Sheffield College Basketball Academy operates within the Elite Sports Academy, with men's and women's teams competing at regional and national levels in AoC and Elite Academy Basketball leagues.

The college provides strong provision in creative and performing arts. Students work in specialist studios and performance spaces, developing practical skills through coursework, projects and assessed performances, with opportunities to build portfolios for progression to creative and media-related university courses.
