Academic Excellence

Kent City High School offers a academic program that includes core courses and an expanded list of electives in technology, arts, and applied subjects. Students may enroll in advanced mathematics and sciences such as Calculus AB/BC, Statistics, Biology, Chemistry, and Environmental Science; as well as specialized options in computer applications and web design. Art, ceramics, multimedia, and multiple music ensembles strengthen the creative curriculum. Small class sizes support individualized instruction. Recent facilities upgrades, including a competition gym and field house, enhance the school's capacity for integrated academic and athletic learning.

Student Accomplishments

- The varsity boys' soccer team secures the first outright conference title in school history and 7 student-athletes earning CSAA All-Conference honors for Fall 2024.
- The school also held its National Honor Society induction ceremony in October 2025
- School's Hall of Fame—established in 1999—continues to recognize alumni who have made significant achievements and contributions to the community.

Campus Facilities

The campus includes upgraded athletic and multipurpose facilities designed to support varied learning and training needs. Recent improvements feature a competition gymnasium, a multipurpose wrestling space, and a fully equipped field house. Classrooms and specialized rooms for art, music, and technology courses provide students with settings for both academic study and hands-on work. Outdoor athletic fields and open surroundings reflect the school's rural location and offer additional space for conditioning, sports, and community activities.

Athletics and Arts

Kent City High School competes in the Central State Activities Association. Athletics play a visible role on campus, supported by renovated facilities and a wide range of seasonal sports. Programs emphasize skill development, conditioning, and team participation across both indoor and outdoor sports.

The arts program includes visual arts and multiple music pathways. Students can develop skills in drawing, painting, sculpture, ceramics, multimedia, and printmaking. Music opportunities include band, choir, orchestra, and individual lessons, enabling students to explore performance and ensemble work.


