Sequoia Charter School is one of the largest public charter schools in Arizona. Sequoia offers dual enrollment courses for college credit as well as an Ambassador program in which all international students are paired with a local student to help them acclimate to the school. 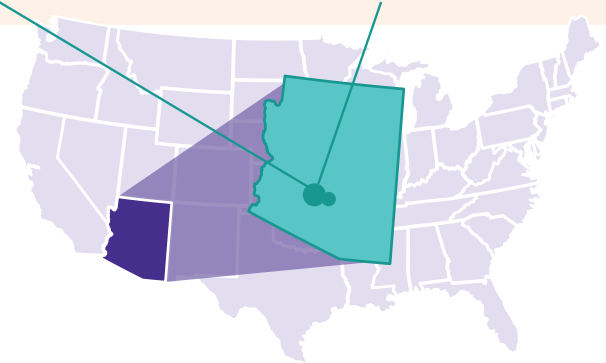
The district aims to prepare students for education in the arts after high school. They offer courses including dance, piano and graphic arts.
